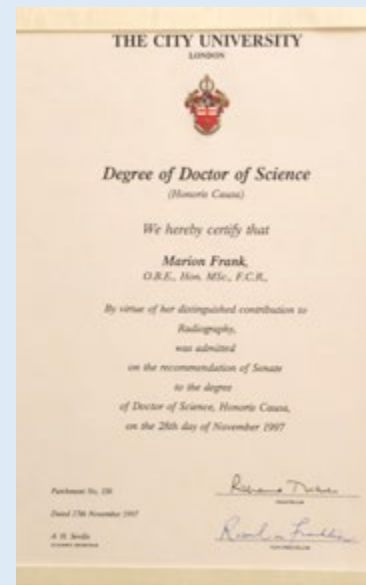
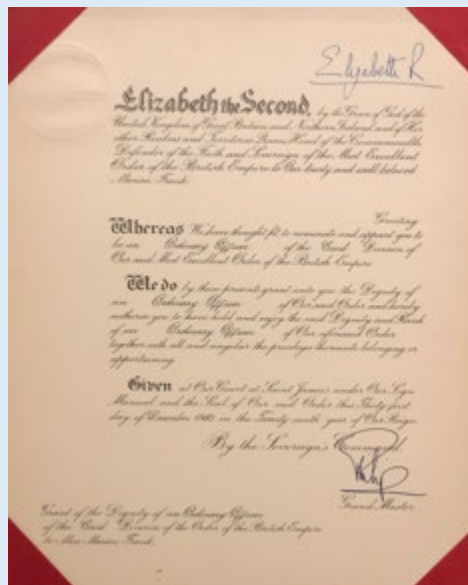
Dear Miss Frank,
